THE CAT'S PYJAMAS COVID 19 POLICY



We are following government guidance as laid out in 'Working safely during coronavirus (COVID-19)' documentation for 'Offices and Contact Centres'. We have undertaken a risk assessment and put appropriate mitigation measures in place.

For the safety of all our members, we request that while using the space that you adhere to the following guidance:

- 1. Please ensure you stay at home and do not attend the premises if you feel unwell or have been in close contact with someone who has Covid 19.
- 2. Please use hand sanitiser on entering and leaving The Cat's Pyjamas.
- 3. Remember to frequently wash your hands throughout the day.
- 4. Please clean your selected desk space before and after use with the surface cleaning products provided at the hand sanitiser station.
- 5. The maximum occupancy for the meeting room is four people. We will continue to encourage mask-wearing in the meeting room due to the enclosed nature of the space.
- 6. As we do not have access to your medical records, we strongly recommend that you do not attend The Cat's Pyjamas if you are considered a clinically vulnerable individual.
- 7. We provide tea and coffee making facilities at The Cat's Pyjamas, feel free to bring your own reusable drinking utensils as an additional safety measure if you would like.
- 8. When choosing your desk space, please work back-to-back or side-to-side (not face-to-face). We have positioned the desks and seats specifically to allow for this work set up. Where this is not possible consider wearing a face mask.
- 9. Please make use of lockers provided to keep your belongings safely in one place.
- 10. Please pay attention to the movements of other members at work in The Cat's Pyjamas and respect peoples wishes to maintain a safe social distance.
- 11. You are encouraged to wear a face mask while walking around the workspace but please feel free to remove them when working at your desk.
- 12. You are encouraged to take regular Lateral Flow Device (LFD) tests to aid early identification of Covid-19 infection. Kits are free from pharmacies and tests can be done at home. We are not requesting evidence of results as a condition of entry at this time.
